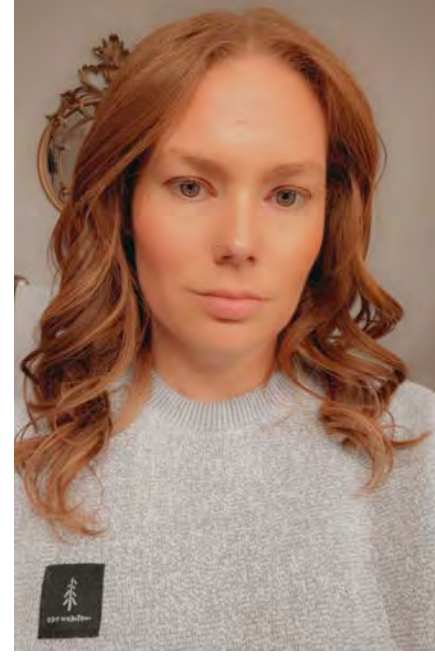
Both Susan and Jason are dedicated professionals in the field of recovery and mental health services, committed to supporting individuals on their path to wellness.
