- 37 futures started

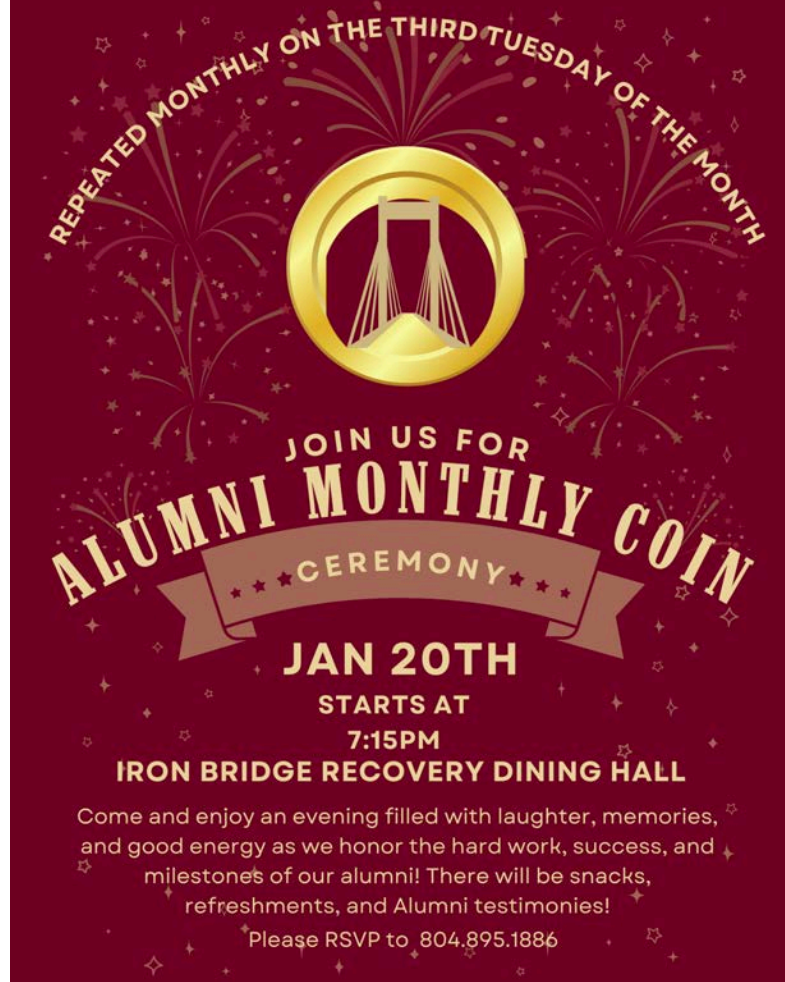
Thank you for sharing your story. The power of your voice and your story is and can change lives.

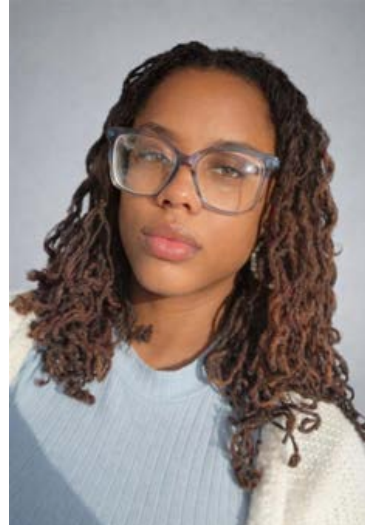

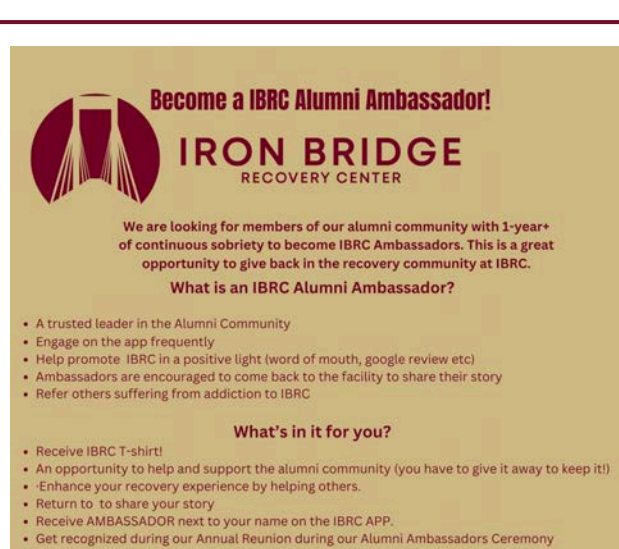
